

**Information Sheet
Kempenfelt Bay
Barrie, Ontario
Saturday, June 18, 2011**

Highlights: An early season row on Kempenfelt Bay, Lake Simcoe, good views of boathouses & designer houses owned by the “Russian Mafia”, local potentates, etc, featuring a **Gourmet Buffet** at the Kempenfelt Conference Centre.

Itinerary

Meet: *Barrie Rowing Club at 9:45AM, (boats are already rigged)*

Put-in: *Barrie Rowing Club dock, around 10:00 – 10:15*

There is an 8-12 km (depending on the weather) morning row. The plan is to row out along the north shore of Kempenfelt Bay, and cross over to the south shore (to the Kempenfelt Conference Centre). If the wind is from the south (unusual), we will row out along the south shore reducing the distance by 3-4km.

Take-out: *a shingle (rounded gravel) beach & grassy area on the south shore at the Kempenfelt Conference Centre.*

Lunch: *At the Kempenfelt Conference Centre. The Centre is owned by Georgian College and catered by Georgian "Hospitality" Students. They do a superb, buffet with soup, various (hot) main course choices, various dessert choices, etc. Eat till you bust, but make sure you can still row in the afternoon! I have been there several times and can attest to the excellence of both meal and presentation (white table cloth).*

Put-in: *There is an 8 km row after lunch, back to the Barrie Rowing Club dock.*

Degree of difficulty of tour: easy – 20km; 16km if the wind is from the south.

Price and inclusions: \$45 including seat charges, lunch, and taxes. We need to receive your cheque by June 3. (Lunch for non-rowers is \$20, incl. tax & tip.)

Eligibility: For insurance and equipment reasons, all participants **must** be members of a member club of the new Ontario Adventure Rowing Association (OAR Touring) or an individual member of the same Association.

Capacity: 20 people in boats (*We can take several extra for lunch only.*)
