

Rideau Nine Lakes Tours

May 28 and 29, 2011

Chaffey's Lock, Ontario

See some of the pristine, beautiful lakes of the Rideau Canal. Experience locking through locks originally built around 1830 -- either Newboro and Chaffey's or Davis Locks. Loons will bob up and down. We will observe an Osprey's Nest.

Stay in a beautiful fishing lodge which has preserved many of its traditions including flavourful and full meals as well as the Liars' Bench.

Itinerary

Day 1 – Saturday, May 28:

10:30 AM -- Arrival at the Opinicon Resort
10:30 AM – Rig boats
13:00 PM – Lunch either at Newboro Locks or Jones Falls
3:30 - 4:00 PM (approx.) – Unload and park boats; check-in at Opinicon Resort Hotel (N.B.: Official check-in time is 4 PM)
6:30 – 7:30 PM – Dinner in dining lounge

Day 2 – Sunday, May 29:

7:30 - 8:30 AM – Breakfast in dining lounge
8:30 AM – Launch; row on Opinicon Lake
11:30 AM – Arrival back at Opinicon boat launch; derig and load boats
12:15 PM -- Check-out (N.B.: Official check-out time is 1 PM)
12:30 - 1:30 PM -- Farewell lunch in dining lounge

Logistics

Price:

- \$175 per person if paid before April 30, 2011; \$185 per person if payment received by May 20, 2011
- The price includes quad rental, quad transport costs, three sit down meals (dinner, breakfast, lunch), one packed lunch, one nights' accommodation in shared cabins, and lock fees.

Rowing Experience: You must be an intermediate sculler or higher who can row 15-20 km on a leisurely early season tour.

Eligibility:

For insurance and equipment reasons, all participants must be members of a member club of the new Ontario Adventure Rowing Association (OAR Touring) or an individual member of the same Association (\$25) (see www.adventurerowing.ca for membership information or pay for a guest trial fee (\$10).

Capacity: 20 individuals. Register early (see next page).

Accommodation: The Opinicon Resort Hotel is a traditional 1920s style lodge set on a beautiful wooden peninsula beside the locks. The cabins have modern facilities. The meals are generous, so you will not be hungry. The dining room does not serve alcohol. The call of the loon can be heard at night. The co-ordinates of the Hotel are:

Directions to Chaffey's Locks: Take Highway 15 from Kingston or Ottawa. Turn west onto Chaffey's Locks Road; drive a few kilometers to Chaffey's Locks; drive through the village. The entrance to the hotel is to the left, just before the locks.

Friday night accommodation: If you wish to arrive early and stay at the Hotel on Friday night, please make your own arrangements. The room types vary, but the cost would be around \$125 + taxes per person per night; cost includes dinner, breakfast, and lunch. Check to see if you can stay in a cabin reserved for Saturday night by the 'Ontario Rowing/Touring' group. Arrive before 6:30 PM, so that you can enjoy the hearty dinner. Please ask for a packed lunch for Saturday. Note that the Opinicon Resort does not take credit cards.
