Madawaska – Conroys Marsh Tour
Combermere, Ontario
Sunday, October 4, 2009

Highlights: *A beautiful fall foliage tour on the Madawaska-Kameniskeg waterway. You row through the reeds of the provincially protected Conroys Marsh. You may be able to see remnants of a ghost town and mine.*

Itinerary

Start: Mayflower Park, Mill St., Combermere at 10 AM

There is a 10-15 km morning row on the Madawaska River, Negeek Lake, and the York River (Conroy Marsh).

Lunch: Lentz landing under Boehmes Mountain or Boffins Point under William Johns Mountain

There is an 10-15 km row after lunch through Conroy Marsh, Negeek Lake, and the Madawaska River

Finish: Mayflower Park, Combermere

Degree of difficulty of tour: moderate

Price and inclusions: \$25 for seat charges. Bring your own lunch.

Eligibility: For insurance and equipment reasons, all participants ***must*** be members of a member club of the new Ontario Adventure Rowing Association (OAR Touring) or an individual member of the same Association (\$75).

Capacity: 25 tourers

Directions to meeting point: Combermere is on Highway 62, south of Barry's Bay. Combermere is 2 hours from Belleville and Peterborough, 2 ½ hours from Ottawa and Orillia, and 3 ¼ hours from Toronto.

The Mayflower Park is on Mill Street, the first street east of the Madawaska River.
