

Upper Ottawa River Rowing Tour

July 31 to August 3, 2009

Mattawa--Deux Rivières--Driftwood Park--Dumoine River

Row on the magnificent and wild Upper Ottawa River where its deep, pristine waters lap at the Laurentian Mountains. Row up the beautiful mouth of the Dumoine River, renowned by canoeists.

Tentative Itinerary

Day 1 – Friday night, July 31: Meet and greet at our cabin accommodation in Deux Rivières, Ontario. If you arrive by 7:00 PM, you can buy dinner at the resort cafe.

Day 2 – Saturday, August 1: This will be a full day of magnificent sculling from Mattawa to Deux Rivières. Saturday night is BBQ and Hawaiian night!

Day 3 – Sunday, August 2: Starting at Deux Rivières, we row on the Ottawa River to Driftwood Provincial Park. At the end of this long row, the beach will be inviting.

Day 4- Monday morning, August 3: We cross the Ottawa River and row upstream on the Dumoine River to the first falls. We aim to be back and derigged by 2 PM at the latest.

Logistics

Price:

- \$200 per person is the base price, if paid after June 1, 2009
- The price includes quad rental, quad transport costs, Saturday and Sunday lunches, an evening barbecue, park fees, as well as three nights' accommodation in shared tipis* and bunk cabins.
- Those in the tipis must bring sleeping bags and pillows; mats are provided.
- An additional charge of no more than \$150 per person if you wish upgraded cottage accommodation; this is payable in cash on site. Slightly cheaper upgrade options may be available, if there is demand.
- We will try to accommodate your sleeping wishes but we cannot in all cases; you must accept the accommodation as assigned
- Breakfasts may be purchased at the Gingerbread Café on site.
- The resort includes a fitness centre, volleyball, horse shoes, and other games.

Rowing Experience: Because of the stamina required, you must be an experienced tourer to participate in this tour. Rowers must be members of the Ontario Adventure Rowing Association or pay a trial guest fee (\$25).

Maximum capacity: 25 individuals
