

Cottage tour 2009 July 18/19 2009

We invite you to a rowing tour on Georgian Bay with an overnight stay at Cathy Cole's cottage, on the edge of the Bay.

Maximum: 20 people –4 boats!!!!

Let's enjoy nature, an outstanding cottage place and some good rowing at low cost.

We meet on July 18.09 at 10 am at the Government dock on 12 Miles Bay.

Directions:

From Toronto Hwy 400 N

At Barrie continue on Highway 400 towards Parry Sound, N. Exit 174, turn left on 12 Miles Bay Road (Road construction in this area)

Continue on 12 Miles Bay Road for 10-12 km to the Government Dock –it is beyond Moose Deer Point Marina –see attached the map-

Allow at least 2 hours drive from Toronto

WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING:

Lunch for Saturday

Evening meal for Saturday night - chili suggested

Snacks, plenty of drink

Breakfast for Sunday

Sleeping bag, Sunscreen, swim suit, clothes for warm, cool and wet weather.

The tour:

After rigging the boats we row 12 km, in a scenic world of islands to Cathy's cottage. Cathy kindly offered to pick up our luggage with her coach boat, but keep the luggage low key.

The cottage is fully equipped, with frigs and fireplaces,

Accommodation is in cabins, but we need sleeping bags and our own food and drinks. We think of Chili con carne, so bring that along for a nice stir. Lots of fun, sandy beach...

Sunday morning we row around the islands and slowly back to the Government dock. At 2 pm we should have derigged and loaded the boats ready for the trip home.

The cost is 80 \$, namely

- 30 \$ for the night, including gas for the coach boat
- 50 \$ boat rental for 2 days.
